Position Summary

We are seeking the aid of a motivated leader and learner who wants to gain tangible ministry experience with mentored direction. This position will be primarily focused on our ministry to youth (6-12 grades) with the assistance of parents and the youth pastor.

This position has a great deal of flexibility based on the availability, training level and gifts of the person taking the role. Here is a brief summary:

Desired Characteristics:

- Devoted follower of Christ with godly character
- Some prior experience in youth work is desirable
- Some ability to lead youth in worship is desirable
- Social skills adequate with the requirements of the job
- Supportive of the mission, vision and values of First Presbyterian Church
- Reliable and teachable team player

Job Responsibilities (10 hours per week):

- Devoting time and energy to learning about gospel ministry in the context of the local church – through experience, meeting with the Pastor and Elders, reading and prayer.
- Growing in the strength of developing Christ-centered, loving and personal relationships with the youth of our congregation.
- Learning the skills of teaching and discipling youth (in various settings) in the Word of God and the ways of a gospel-centered follower of Christ.
- Facilitating and aiding in the execution of different youth events throughout the year.
- Meet with the Youth Pastor to establish and review specific ministry goals and objectives.

Compensation will be commensurate to hourly work. Work days and hours will be discussed with the Youth Pastor.
